

SSi People: Social Impact, Diversity, and Inclusion

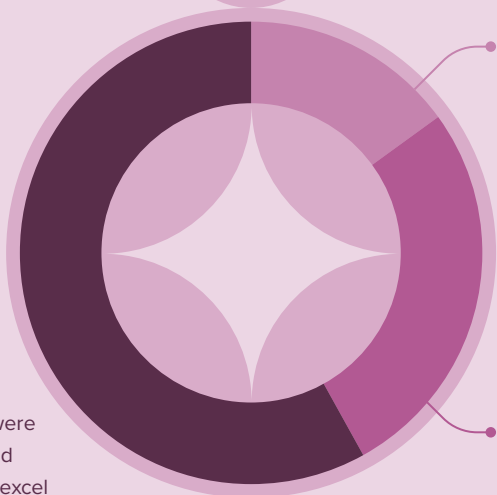


Diversity is not a trend to us; it is part of our identity.

He believed that if women were given the opportunity to build flexible careers, they would excel as contributors and leaders.

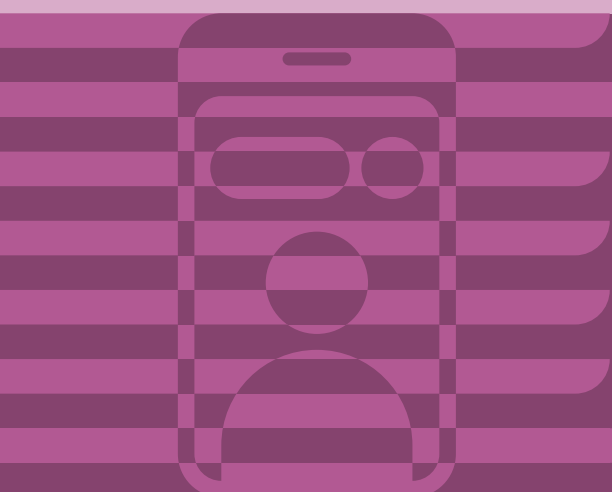
